Capacity: 10 people in building, not including staff. Maximum 3 people, not including staff during the special hour for our At Risk Patrons.

Browsing: Quick book browsing allowed. All materials touched to go into bins for quarantining.

Time Limit to no more than 60 minutes.

Meeting Room: Closed to the Public

Bathrooms: Open to the Public

Children's Play Area: Dramatic Play Center, puzzles, and toys will remain in storage until threat of COVID-19 has subsided.

All in person programming is suspended at this time until the threat is passed.

Public Computers: By Appointment Only, 2 Computers available to adhere to social distancing guidelines.

- 1-hour time slots, Necessary work only, no gaming.
- If patron needs assistance, a mask is required by both patron and staff if they need staff to be within 6 ft. of them.
- Computers to be cleaned after each use.
